

## **Extended Outlook:**

Davis - Casey: A weak AR will skirt the stations starting on Monday but will have minimal advances into the interior.

Ross Island area: No AR's expected as the broad steering flow remains off Marie Byrd Land over the central Ross Ice Shelf.

**Palmer area:** Cyclones will move through the Drake Passage producing weak AR's in the Northern sector through Monday. A strong ridge will provide a brief pause in activity early next week.

## Discussion Date Issued: 08-08-2022

The only major Jet activity remains over Western Antarctica which is weakening but will drive an intrusion into the Peninsula with one AR migrating into the Ross Ice Shelf by mid-week. The flow will keep intrusions over east Antarctica to a minimum this period.
